Located within 2,000km of East Asia's major cities, Fukuoka has numerous direct international flights and thanks to this accessibility is the only city in East Asia where same-day international conferences are possible. Taking advantage of this strategic location, many important Asia-Pacific meetings have been held here, including the historic "Japan-China-Korea Trilateral Summit" at the Kyushu National Museum in Dazaifu. The city also offers smooth access to European and American cities through international hub airports.

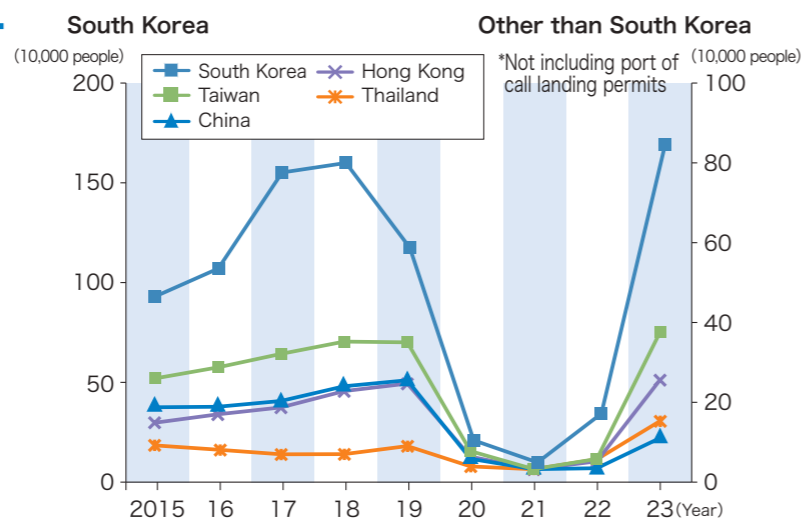

In 2023 record breaking 2.75 million foreign visitors came to Fukuoka.

The number of foreign visitors entering through Fukuoka Airport and Hakata Port had set new records for seven consecutive years until 2018. After peaking at 2.56 million in 2018, numbers dropped significantly during the COVID-19 pandemic but improved in 2022 before setting a new record in 2023. Visitors from South Korea lead the numbers, followed by Taiwan, Hong Kong, and Thailand. Growth rates are again showing significant increases from the Philippines, Singapore, Vietnam, Malaysia, and the United States.

Fukuoka's airport-to-city access ranks among the world's best. Just 5 minutes by subway from Fukuoka Airport to Hakata Station (the central station), and 10 minutes to Tenjin (downtown). Within a 2.5km radius, you'll find the airport, meeting facilities, and city center. The compact downtown area features shrines, temples, beach resorts, and cutting-edge shopping facilities in close proximity - a city where Japanese tradition and modernity coexist.

G20 Fukuoka Finance Ministers and Central Bank Governors Meeting

The meeting was held in Fukuoka City on June 8-9, 2019. Tourism information and souvenir sales were provided at special booths in the Hilton Fukuoka Seahawk and Jotenji Temple (where international media events were held), promoting Fukuoka's food and culture to domestic and international participants.



World Aquatics Championships Fukuoka 2023

The World Aquatics Championships Fukuoka 2023 was held in Fukuoka City in July 2023, marking the second time in 22 years. The World Aquatics Masters Championships 2023 Kyushu was held across three cities: Fukuoka, Kumamoto, and Kagoshima. The official event space and fan zone in front of Hakata Station and the venue Marine Messe Fukuoka welcomed approximately 10,000 swimming fans from around the world with traditional Japanese hospitality.

Fukuoka Growth Next

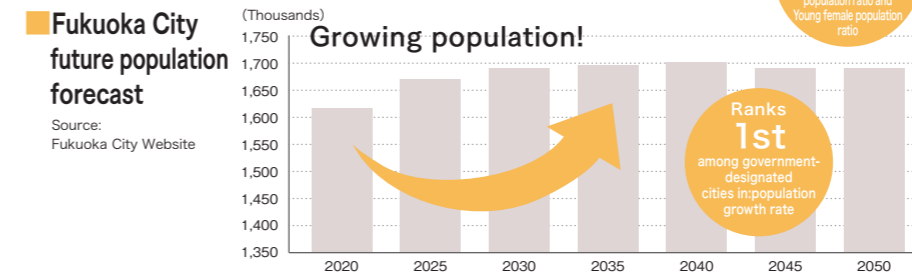

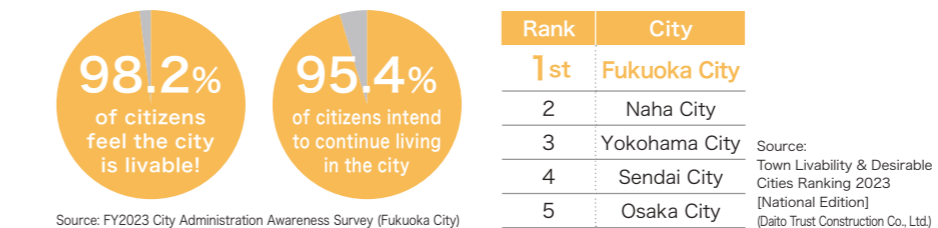

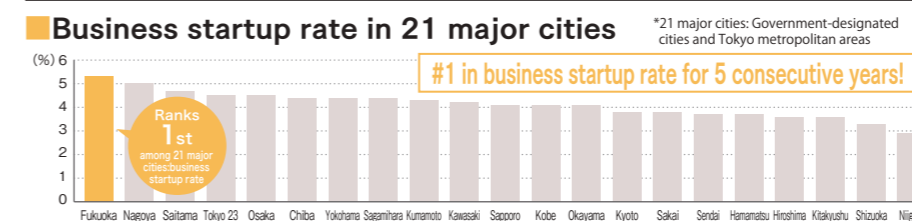


Fukuoka City: The most livable city

FY2023 City Administration Awareness Survey | "Most Desirable Cities to Live" Ranking



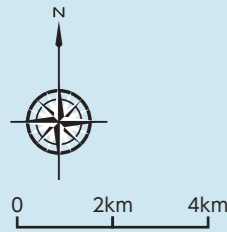
Top business startup rate among 21 major cities!

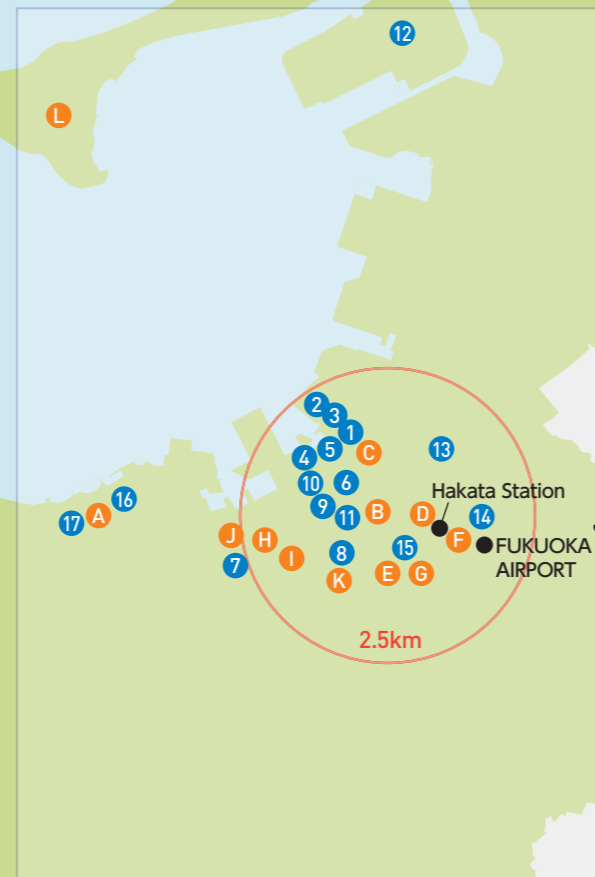

1 World's New Three Best Night Views

2 Glover Garden

Located on Minamiyamate Hill overlooking a panoramic view of Nagasaki Port, preserving the atmosphere of the former foreign settlement era.



3 Gunkanjima (Hashima Island)

Formerly a prosperous coal mining island, Hashima is nicknamed " Battleship Island" due to its resemblance to a military vessel. Registered as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2015. Popular landing tours available to visit the island.

Northern Area [Saga Prefecture]



4 Imari & Arita Porcelain

Distinctive styles such as Ko-Imari, Kakiemon, and Nabeshima patterns stand out on translucent white porcelain.



5 Saga International Balloon Fiesta

Asia's largest hot air balloon festival held in early November at the Kase River basin in Saga City as the main venue.



6 Karatsu

A city filled with various attractions including: Beautiful Karatsu Castle, Gourmet food from the Genkai Sea, Nationally renowned Karatsu pottery. Perfect for a leisurely historical stroll.

Central Area [Kumamoto Prefecture]



7 Kumamoto Castle

Built in 1607 by Kato Kiyomasa. The main palace (Honmaru Goten) and its luxurious interiors were restored to commemorate the castle's 400th anniversary.



8 Aso

Mount Aso's five peaks and one of the world's largest calderas are recognized as "Earth Heritage" in the Japanese geopark. Scenery changes throughout the four seasons, offering visitors ever-changing views.



9 Kurokawa Onsen

Each ryokan has its own hot spring source with distinctive characteristics in scent, color, and mineral content. Popular "Bath-Hopping Pass" (¥1,200) allows access to three different outdoor baths. *Direct express bus available from Fukuoka/Fukuoka Airport to Kurokawa Onsen

Central Area [Oita Prefecture]



10 Beppu Onsen

A hot spring town where modern development coexists with traditional onsen atmosphere. Features various types of hot springs and boasts Japan's largest volume of hot spring water output.



11 Yufuin Onsen

A nationally renowned and popular hot spring resort with diverse accommodation options. At Kiririn Lake, the symbol of Yufuin, visitors can witness mystical scenes of morning mist over the water surface from late autumn to winter mornings.



12 Kokonoe "Yume" Grand Suspension Bridge

Japan's largest suspension bridge. 390m long, 173m high, at an elevation of 777m. Offers spectacular views from the bridge. Several hot springs scattered in the surrounding area for onsen hopping.

Southern Area [Miyazaki Prefecture]



13 Takachiho Gorge

A valley featuring cliffs formed by Aso volcanic lava. Manai Falls, selected as one of Japan's top 100 waterfalls, is illuminated in summer creating a mystical atmosphere. Impressive views of the waterfall and cliffs can be enjoyed from rental boats below.

Southern Area [Kagoshima Prefecture]



14 Sakurajima

An active volcano of global significance, still emitting smoke and ash. It is a composite active volcano consisting of Kita-dake, Naka-dake, and Minami-dake mountain, and there are many records of eruptions since ancient times.



15 Ibusuki Onsen

Famous for natural sand baths (sunamushi onsen) where visitors lie on the beach while attendants cover them with hot Spring-heated sand. Said to be more effective than regular hot springs. Popular among women for its anti-inflammatory effects and ability to enhance skin metabolism.
